- Holy Communion will be received on the hand only and in your seat.
- There is limited seating so please arrive in plenty of time.
- Please bring your own mask with you for the Masses and adhere to all social distancing and health advice.
- Please adhere to the advice of volunteers, stewards and security.

Confessions:

- 12pm – 3pm in the Reconciliation Chapel. **(NO CONFESSIONS ON MONDAY)**
- Please bring your own mask with you and adhere to advice given for your protection.

Private Prayer:

- 9am – 8pm in the Basilica
- In order to accommodate everyone, it is recommended that you spend no more than 15 minutes.
- Please bring your own mask and adhere to advice given for your protection.

Mass Office and Bookshop:

- 9am – 5pm
