Christmas Day: 8am, 10 am and 12pm midday

- You MUST bring your **printed** ticket with you, otherwise no entry.
- Please queue at least 30mins before Mass
- Please follow the guidance of volunteers and security staff.
- Please wear a mask and sanitise hands on entry.

## Mass times after Christmas Day:

No tickets required and queue on a first come first entry basis. If Masses are in the **"Basilica"** it means they are open to the public. If **"online"** follows the time below it means they are online only and not open to the public.
