Eurovision Mass for the Feast of the Assumption

Sunday 15 August

On the 15th August, the Feast of the Assumption, a special Eurovision Mass will be celebrated and broadcast live from the Basilica.

The main celebrant will be Fr Richard Gibbons. The liturgy will feature music by the Schola Cantorum Basilicae under the direction of Úna Nolan with Organist Mark Keane.

The Mass will be broadcast on television on RTÉ 1 at 10am and also via the Eurovision Global Network, making it available to watch in France, Belgium, the Netherlands and Switzerland.

Attendance at the Mass will be restricted to 200 people on a first-come, first-served basis with strict queuing systems in place.

There will be no Rosary at 2.30pm on Sunday 15 August

All Masses will take place in the Basilica.

Attendance at Mass is limited to a max. of 200 people on a first-come, first-served basis.
