Text Scams:

Recently, there has been an increase in reports of Text Scams in the Knock Area. If you receive a text message from a delivery company, Financial Institution or other such business, verify their phone number by ringing them rather than clicking on any links attached.

These text scammers are using a 'hyperlink' to bring their unsuspecting victim to a fake website. Hyperlinks are a blue coded text attached to the text. The advice from An Garda Síochána is never to click on this blue link unless you are happy that it is safe to do so.
